



Handy Checklist

- Confirm dates with Whites Removals.
- Dispose of anything you don't want.
- Clean out the freezer.
- Contact carpet fitters if needed.
- Notify Doctor, Dentist, Optician, Vet.
- Make suitable arrangements to look after your pets.
- Tell your Bank and saving/share accounts.
- Inform Telephone Company and ISP.
- Ask Post Office to re-direct mail.
- Notify TV licence, passport, car licence and registration offices.
- Inform Utility companies.
- Tell friends and relatives.
- Clear loft.
- Check Parking – If there are restrictions at either house you may need to reserve space for parking.
- Unloading – Notify us of obstructions such as poor access, small doors and stairways, trees nearby, or any other problem you can think of.
- Planning – Work out where you want your possessions in your new home. Drawing up a plan and make sure someone is on hand to show where things go.
